FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURE

If the **Automatic Fire Alarm System** is activated an **ALERT** tone will be heard in all units and common areas.

This **ALERT** tone will be heard for approximately 10 minutes.

NSW Fire and Rescue Brigade will automatically respond and will go directly to the Fire Indicator Panel in the Control Room.

On hearing the **ALERT** tone, occupants should investigate if there are any signs of Fire near them and check to see that the **PATH of TRAVEL** to the **FIRE STAIRS** is clear.

If there are any signs of fire occupants must implement the **RACE** plan.

R – REMOVE any persons from danger

A – ALERT any persons of the danger

C –CONFINE the fire by closing any doors

E- EXTINGUISH the fire only if it is safe to do so

If you cannot evacuate because of the fire or because of a disability remain in your apartment with the entry door closed. **CALL 000** and request **FIRE AND RESCUE**. Inform the operator of your exact location (Hyde Park Towers, 148 Elizabeth Street Sydney and your apartment number) then follow the operator's instructions.

If there is **NO SIGN** of fire remain in your apartment with the entry door closed and wait for the **ALERT** signal to either stop or change.

After 10 minutes the **ALERT** signal will change to an **EVACUATE NOW** voice command. On hearing **EVACUATE NOW** exit the building immediately via the **FIRE STAIRS** and assemble at the rear of the building in Nithsdale Street.

DO NOT USE THE LIFTS as they will be automatically positioned to the ground floor for use by NSW Fire and Rescue Officers **ONLY**.
